



TOWN OF ROCKINGHAM

Town Profile 2005

(2000 U.S. Census)

POPULATION

-  In 2000, the median age of the town's population was 39, up from 34 in 1990. The median age in the region also increased from 36 in 1990 to 40 in 2000.
-  Rockingham's population accounted for 12% of the region's 46,449 people in 2000.
-  Rockingham ranked as the second largest town in both 2000 and in 1990. It has also experienced the greatest loss of population out off all the towns in the Windham Region.




-  The population of Rockingham decreased 4% between 1980-2000, from 5,538 to 5,309 people.
-  Population density in 2000 was 126.7 persons per square mile, a 4% decrease from 132.5 persons per square mile in 1990.
-  15% of the population in 2000 was 64 years or older while 6% of the population was 5 years or younger.
-  Between 1990 and 2000, the town's population decreased 3%. The region experienced a 5% growth during those same years.

HOUSING


-  Rockingham had 2,202 households in 2000, up from 2,155 in 1990.
-  There was a 21% decrease in vacant housing units between 1980 and 2000.

-  Between 1990-2000, the total number of housing units decreased by 2%. There was a 17% decrease in seasonal units and a 7% increase in owner occupied units.
-  The average household size in Rockingham decreased from 2.54 persons in 1990 to 2.39 persons in 2000. The region's average household size also decreased during this period, from 2.49 in 1990 to 2.35 in 2000.
-  Rockingham's share of the region's seasonal housing supply remained at about 1% in 1990 (101 units) and in 2000 (84 units).
-  The median gross rent in 2000 was \$447, down from \$558 (adjusted to 2000 dollars) in 1990. The region's median gross rent in 2000 was \$552.




INCOME

- § The median household income in 2000 was \$33,423, up from the 1990 median household income of \$31,565 (adjusted to 2000 dollars).
- § In 2000, 19% of all households earned less than \$15,000 per year while in 1990, 32% earned less than \$15,000 per year.
- § In 2000, 49% of all households earned more than \$35,000 per year while in 1990, 29% earned more than \$35,000 per year.
- § 6% of households received public assistance in 2000.
- § 34% of households received social security income in 2000.



- § 10% of the population fell below the poverty level in 2000. 9% of the population of the Windham Region and 9% of the population of the State fell below the poverty level in 2000.

EMPLOYMENT



In 2000, the education, health and social service fields employed the largest percentage of employed workers residing in Rockingham (26%).


The number of employed workers residing in Rockingham who were age 16 and older increased 3% between 1990 and 2000.

Manufacturing experienced the largest decrease of Rockingham residents employed in that industry between 1990 and 2000 with a 27% decrease.

Rockingham residents traveled an average of 18.2 minutes to work in 2000, a slight decrease from 18.4 minutes in 1990. The regional average travel time increased 22% from 1990 (18.9 minutes) to 2000 (22 minutes).

In 2000, 16% of employed workers residing in Rockingham worked at home or walked to work, an increase from 12% in 1990.

73% of Rockingham residents drove alone to work in 2000 while 71% drove alone in 1990. The number of residents carpooling to work dropped from 15% in 1990 to 11% in 2000.
