AGREEMENT

BELLOWS FALLS VILLAGE CORPORATION  
AND  
NORTH WESTMINSTER VILLAGE CORPORATION

THIS AGREEMENT made and concluded on the day and date hereinafter set forth by and between the Bellows Falls Village Corporation, a municipal corporation located in the Town of Rockingham, County of Windham and State of Vermont, hereinafter referred to as "B.F.V.C." acting through its Board of Trustees on the one part and the North Westminister Village Corporation, a municipal corporation in the Town of Westminister in said County and State, hereinafter referred to as "N.W.V.C." acting through its Board of Trustees on the other part.

## WITNESSETH:

THAT WHEREAS the residents of N.W.V.C. are faced with the necessity of providing proper sewage disposal and treatment to relieve the unsanitary conditions that now exist in said Village, and

WHEREAS, B.F.V.C. has at the present time a sewage disposal and treatment facility which is capable of receiving and properly treating sewage from N.W.V.C. and

WHEREAS, an engineering study of the sewage problem in N.W.V.C. has been made by its engineering firm and as a result of said study it has been recommended that sewage from N.W.V.C. be piped to and disposed of through the sewage treatment facility of B.F.V.C.,

NOW THEN in consideration of the payment of rents or rates by N.W.V.C. to B.F.V.C. it is hereby agreed by the parties hereto as follows:

1. N.W.V.C. may lay a pipe for the transportation of sewage from the N.W.V.C. to the sewer line of B.F.V.C. located approximately at the junction of West and Saxtons River Streets in said B.F.V.C. and connect the same for discharge of sewage into the sewage treatment facility of B.F.V.C. The sewage to be discharged into the system of B.F.V.C. shall be limited to domestic sewage and no discharge of industrial waste shall be made into the system of B.F.V.C. without N.W.V.C. first obtaining the written consent of B.F.V.C. Domestic sewage shall be defined as the wastewater

from houses, apartments, office buildings, institutions and commercial establishments. Industrial sewage shall mean wastewater from industrial manufacturing processes, trade or business as distinct from domestic sewage.

2. N.W.V.C. shall make payment due the first of each year at the same rate per 100 cubic feet for the treatment and disposition of the sewage from N.W.V.C. as users residing in the B.F.V.C. It is agreed that the following are the figures to be used as estimated annual flows:

1 Family Unit	10,700 CF
2 Family Unit	18,600 CF
3 Family Unit	25,000 CF
4 Family Unit	32,800 CF

Anything beyond four units will be subject to review.

3. N.W.V.C. shall maintain and service the N.W.V.C. system.

4. Disposal of sewage by N.W.V.C. and its residents is and shall be subject to all applicable provisions of the sewer use ordinance of the B.F.V.C. and any future amendments thereof.

5. N.W.V.C. users of the B.F.V.C. sewage system shall have the same rights and obligations as B.F.V.C. resident users and shall be subject to the same legal defenses.

6. The flows set forth in paragraph 2 above shall be subject to review at the request of the B.F.V.C. or the N.W.V.C. in accord with requirements contained in User Charge Systems for both Corporations.
